On Wednesday, October 21, 2015, at 7:30 P.M., Hanover Township Council introduced Bill No. 2015-5, An Ordinance Amending the Hanover Township Zoning Ordinance to Permit Directional Signs in Certain Zones.

The Public Hearing on said Bill No. 2015-5 will be held on Wednesday, December 2, 2015, at 7:30 p.m., at the Hanover Township Municipal Building, 2202 Grove Road Allentown, PA 18109. The Hanover Township Council will consider passage of the proposed Ordinance at the same meeting.

Bill No. 2015-5 provides for directional signs in the Township's Limited Use, Flood Hazard, Planned Residential, Medium Residential, Planned Commercial, Planned Unit Development, Planned Industrial Office, and Airport Industrial Zoning Districts. In PR and MR Districts, on lots with multiple apartment buildings, and in PC, PUD, PIO and AI Zoning Districts, a directional sign may be placed for each approaching lane of traffic at internal driveway intersections. Such signs may not exceed eight (8) square feet and shall be erected so as not to obscure the vision of vehicle drivers at such intersection.

Copies of this proposed Ordinance are on file with the Township Clerk (Township Building) and may be inspected by the public during normal business hours.
